Rules and Regulations for Campers

GATE, VEHICLE RULES AND SET-UP INFORMATION FOR CAMPERS

- *Volunteer set up, Wednesday, June 18th for Thursday and Event volunteers only.*
- **Official set-up day** is Thursday, June 19th **GATE TIMES: 9 AM to 8 PM**
- Gate Times for Friday, June 20th, 7 AM to 8:30 AM for camp set up & 5:30 PM to 8PM.
- Gate Times for Saturday, June 21st, 7 AM to 8:30 AM for camp set up & 5:30 PM to 8PM.
- Gate Times for Sunday, June 22nd, 7 AM to 8:30 AM.
- **Camp will break at 2:15 P.M. on Sunday after the grounds have been cleared of public visitors.**
- NOTICE! If you arrive unregistered, the fee is \$40.00 at the gate per adult. Registration is important for planning.
- Vehicles need to be removed from the Camping area no later than 30 minutes after the gate closes. This rule is in effect from Thursday June 19th through Sunday June 22nd. Driving in camp after dark not only ruins the ambiance but imposes a danger to people walking around.
- Limit your trips into the camping area with a vehicle to once for set-up and once for tear down. **Frequent, unnecessary vehicle trips ruin the event ambiance and experience for others.**
- **No vehicles allowed in camp overnight Thursday through Sunday.**

OPEN TO THE PUBLIC

- Market Fair Open to the Public: Friday 9AM-5PM, Saturday (9AM-5PM), Sunday (9AM-2PM)

PERIOD ATTIRE & CAMP ETIQUETTE:

- All participants must be dressed in CORRECT period attire within the 1730 to 1790 span for the entire duration of this event. This includes after hours, after the public leaves.
- All period shelters must conform to replicate those in existence and commonly used during this historic period. These include, lean-tos, diamond shelters, marquees, wall and wedge tents only.
- All camp furnishings such as stools, benches, chairs and tables as well as fire irons, grates and cookware and all lighting must be period correct for the time span listed above. **(If you have lighted candles and or a campfire you MUST have a full bucket of water available at all times within easy reach.)**
- **Drunkness will not be tolerated.**
- **QUIET TIME in the camp will be 11 PM to 7 AM and will be enforced.**

BLANKET TRADING RULES:

- Campers may set up a trade blanket in their camp area only. All items upon a trade blanket must be correct for the 1730 to 1790 period. Day-trippers may blanket trade in the camper area. NO blanket trading in the artisan area.

ANIMALS:

- Dogs are permitted but must be leashed at all times and curbed.
- Owner is fully responsible and liable for pet. Livestock (horses, chickens, goats): Are allowed as long as they fulfill an interpretative function. Owner is fully responsible/liable for livestock and for cleaning up after.

Photography:

- No solicitation of photography.

NO MODERN FIREARMS ARE PERMITTED AT THIS EVENT. Flintlock firearms ONLY to be discharged at Ranges.

Port-a-potties, firewood and drinking water will be provided at designated locations. ICE for sale at Patton House

Artisans will be open for business during the hours of 9AM to 5PM on Friday & Saturday and 9AM to 2PM on Sunday.

James Smith's Firelock Competition

- Individual marksmen will have the opportunity to competitively match their shooting skill against other marksmen utilizing flintlock weapons (rifled or smoothbored).
 - The shooting competition will feature both period type targets and period shooting procedures.
 - Period scoring will be utilized to identify the best marksman from among the contestants.
 - Prize goes to top shooter awarded during Saturday evening social.
